NSW Crane Crew Refresher Training



Purpose of NSW Crane Crew Refresher Training

The purpose of Crane Crew Refresher Training is to ensure that crane operators, doggers and riggers maintain the competencies originally achieved in the relevant certificates of competency. It is particularly relevant for persons who have not continuously worked in the prescribed occupation. Refresher training is available to crane operators, doggers and riggers on an ongoing basis from Koolat Safety. Koolat Safety is able to provide training and assessment to ensure compliance with the relevant section of the NSW Occupational Health and Safety Regulation 2001. (See "References" below).

Elements from Units of Competency from the **CPC08 Construction, Plumbing and Services Integrated Framework** National Training Package combined with elements from the **TLI07 Transport and Logistics Training Package (Version 2)** National Training Package make up the training course. Relevant sections of the NSW Occupational Health and Safety Regulation 2001 are also covered.

NSW Crane Crew Refresher Training can reflect issues such as:


- (a) the application of new technology, particularly for those persons who obtained their certificates while working on more basic or older cranes;
- (b) any relevant changes to workplace health and safety legislation, Codes of Practice and Australian Standards which may have an impact on safe crane operations.

Koolat Safety refresher training may include:

- (a) conducting a training needs analysis to identify the particular training needs of individual crane crew members;
- (b) providing theoretical information, where required; and
- (c) providing practical demonstration and supervision where required.

Frequency of refresher training

It is suggested that the interval between refresher training courses should not exceed three years. Crane operators, doggers and riggers should undergo refresher training between two and a half and three years after either being issued with their initial certificate of competency, or since attending their most recent refresher training, whichever is the shorter time frame.

Occupational Health and Safety Regulation 2001

13 Employer to provide instruction, training and information

- (1) An employer must ensure that each new employee receives induction training that covers the following:
- (a) arrangements at the place of work for the management of occupational health and safety, including arrangements for reporting hazards to management,
 - (b) health and safety procedures at the place of work relevant to the employee, including the use and maintenance of risk control measures,
 - (c) how employees can access any health and safety information that the employer is required by this Regulation to make available to employees,
 - (d) any other matter that this Regulation specifies should be the subject of induction training and that is relevant to the place of work concerned having regard to the competence, experience and age of the new employee.

Maximum penalty: Level 3.

- (2) An employer must ensure that any person who may be exposed to a risk to health and safety at the employer's place of work:
- (a) is informed of the risk, and
 - (b) is provided with any information, instruction and training necessary to ensure the person's health and safety.

The information, instruction and training (and the timing of its provision) must be commensurate with the risk to health and safety concerned.

Course Costs

The course duration is 4 hours. Refresher training will cost \$250 for each participant. "Out of hours" training is conducted for a fee of \$300 per course. Further training can be provided based on a Training Needs Analysis.
