This new training program is competency based and will have the following components:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • 1 day off-site training covering the following: <ul style="list-style-type: none"> ○ Underpinning theoretical learning ○ Written assessment ○ Practical training in a controlled situation ○ Practical assessment in a controlled situation. • A minimum of 20 hours work based activity under the direct supervision of an experienced licenced traffic controller. • Practical assessment in the workplace. • Third party report acknowledging the candidate has the required knowledge and skills. <p>We are aware that as this new format will take effect as of 1 July 2010 further changes are yet to be approved before full implementation can take effect. We have been advised that the Practical assessment and work based activity components will initially not take effect until later in the year. - Implementing traffic guidance schemes
- Record keeping

- Traffic Management for Construction or Maintenance Work Code of Practice 2008

Assessment

An open book written assessment that focuses on the participant's ability to read and interpret the Manual of Uniform Traffic Control Devices Part 3 (MUTCD)

Participants who do not meet the benchmark will be required to complete further training before re-assessment.

Participants must have sound literacy skills.

Course Award

Candidates are required to demonstrate competence in accordance with 30864QLD Implement Traffic Guidance Schemes by implementing three **(3)** traffic guidance schemes on live roadwork job sites prior to a **Statement of Attainment** being issued.

Candidates not wishing to complete the practical assessment will be issued with a **Statement of Attendance**.

NB: To achieve competence in this unit both the theory and practical assessments must be successfully completed.
